You Asked for:

Please would you let me know in writing if you hold information of the following description: data regarding the total number of under-18s in England who have received help for alcohol addiction-related problems in the past ten years.

In other words, please provide me with the number of persons up to the age of 18 who have been treated for alcohol addiction from 2005-2015.

Where possible, please supply a breakdown of age and sex of person treated for alcohol-related problems. E.g. "In 2012, 45 14-year-olds were treated for alcohol-related problems."

I would like a copy of the information and would prefer for it to be sent by email if possible.

If any part of the information requested is covered by one or more of the absolute exemptions in the Act please treat this request as a request for that part of the information which is not covered by the absolute exemption.

If you need further details in order to identify the information requested or a fee is payable please let me know as soon as possible.

If you are of the view that there may be further information of the kind requested but it is held by another public authority please let me know as soon as possible.
