## You Asked for:

In each of the three years 2015, 2016 and 2017, how many children in Wirral have received over 20 hours' care a week funded under CCC?

## **Our Response:**

We have liaised further with our Finance Team and Continuing Healthcare (CHC) Team who have advised that hourly care is not recorded by NHS Wirral Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG). We are however able to provide the number of packages allocated in the timeframes, but they are not broken down by hours.

The number of Children's Packages that started in each Financial Year are as follows:

2015/16 103 2016/17 103 2017/18 (to date) 68
