How much money has been invested on the Docman 10 project to date?

Our Response:

NHS Wirral Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) and GP Practices have embarked on an ambitious journey to improve and simplify their IT estate and environment during 2018/19. A key component of this investment is the Docman 10 Upgrade project. The principal aim of the project is to implement a hosted document management solution using the PCTi Docman Share solution as a starting point and migrating across all GP practices within the boundary of NHS Wirral CCG to the Docman 10 Cloud Solution. The practices and federated services within NHS Wirral CCG are moving to a more agile workforce where access to hosted solutions will support access to patient information at the point of care.

NHS Wirral CCG was successful in securing full-funding through the ETTF (Estates & Technology Transformation Fund) from NHS England. The total investment for this project is £116,480.51, which is comprised of £79,500 for PCTi technical migration/ implementation services and £36,980.51 for Midlands and Lancashire CSU project management and application/ technical support.
