Thank you for your request for information made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, which was received into this office on 13th October 2020.

You Asked for:

I am writing with a Freedom of Information request regarding prices for Mental Health services. Please provide the average price per day and per week for the year 2020, 2019, 2018 and the following levels for independent and NHS provision:

- Psychiatric Intensive Care Units (PICU)
- Locked rehab
- Open rehab

Please provide average price per day and per week for the year 2020, 2019, 2018 for the following specialities for independent and NHS provision:

- Complex Learning Disability (LD) and Autism spectrum disorder (ASD)
- General Learning disability
- General Mental health
- Rehabilitation
- High functioning ASD
- Old age

Our Response:

NHS Wirral Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) commission Cheshire and Wirral Partnership NHS Foundation Trust (CWP) to provide Mental Health services on behalf of our local population. The provider is commissioned in a block contract and the total contract value across 2018 - 2020 is as follows:

- 2018/2019 - £34,340,332
- 2019/2020 – £38,245,866
- 2020/2021 – £38,281,169 (mandated block)

Unfortunately, we are unable to provide a financial breakdown across the services that have been requested as NHS Wirral CCG does not hold that level of information. Please can I suggest that you contact the provider directly. I have included their contact details below for information:
