Please note from 01 July 2022, Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) were disestablished, and their statutory functions and responsibilities inherited by NHS Cheshire and Merseyside ICB.

Your Request:

In the last 10 years, considering the 'footprint' of the Cheshire and Merseyside ICB, please answer the following questions

- 1) How many wards have been closed in total and in mental health wards?
- 2) Name those which have been closed and tell me their names, where they were located and their purpose adult, old age, child /adolescent. forensic, mental health, surgical, cancer etc... How many beds have been lost in each?
- 3) How many new wards have been opened in this time? Where? What are their names and purpose? And how many beds are available in each?
